Our programs are aligned with research-based practices to support learning in and out of school so kids can succeed in their journey to college and career readiness.



MENU OF STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES



ACADEMIC INTERVENTIONS PROGRAMS • SERVES K-8TH

Provide small-group academic support to students who thrive in a more personable setting. Think Together will provide trained academic coaches and tailor the programs to meet the need around subject area, grade level, curriculum mastery, and specific needs of the students.



ASES EXPANSION PROGRAMS • SERVES TK-8TH

Expand the hours of your existing After School Education and Safety (ASES) program to accommodate TK and Kindergarten students or students currently on the wait list. ASES Expansion can also provide comprehensive after-school programs, from school-day dismissal until 6:00pm, at schools not funded by ASES grants.



BEFORE SCHOOL ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS • SERVES K-8TH

Expand student supervision and enrichment to extend into the before-school hours. Typically offered as support to working families in the school, the program allows students to use the early hours productively and creatively with caring Think Together staff administering activities consistent with our afterschool enrichment curriculum.



HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS • SERVES 9TH-12TH

Offer High School Programs that build upon the many supports that are currently in place within a school by expanding both the breadth and capacity of those services, aligned with the academic, career and college readiness goals of partner schools.

- **Academic Intervention and Tutoring Services:** Offers extended academic support in either small groups or one-to-one on school day curriculum, tailored to meet students' needs.
- **ASSETs Replication Programs:** Provides identical after school enrichment and academic support to high schools that do not qualify for ASSETs grants.
- **Workforce Readiness Education Program (WREP) Workshops:** Focuses on career exploration and preparedness, including application/resume writing, interview skills, guest speakers and internships.



INTERMURAL SPORTS PROGRAMS • SERVES 6TH-8TH

Students have the opportunity to participate in seasonal sports leagues, including flag football, basketball and soccer, with each season culminating in regional tournaments. Team sports promote teamwork, confidence, sportsmanship, conflict resolution, and healthy living through physical activity.



KINDER GAP PROGRAMS • SERVES TK AND K

Leverage an extended school day to support the growth of kinder-age students through hands-on learning, focused on cognitive development. Students learn independently through different areas throughout the classroom and learn leadership skills through different roles and daily routines.



LICENSED SCHOOL AGE CARE PROGRAMS • SERVES K-8TH

Provide before and after school supervision and guidance for youth outside the regular school day. Licensed School Age Care Programs provide students with a safe, caring, and nurturing place for extended learning and development of social, recreational, and personal life skills and complements the educational program of the schools.



NOON AIDES OVERSIGHT PROGRAMS • SERVES K-8TH

The Noon Aides Supervision Programs provides schools with the management of trained staff to sustain safe supervision of students during the school day. Think Together provides turn-key support including hiring, training, background checks and uniforms.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS • SERVES K-8TH

Delivered during school hours, physical education classes meet the PE requirements for both elementary and middle schools, while providing teachers release time to engage in planning, collaboration or student data reflection. PE classes are supervised by certificated teachers.



STEAM ACADEMY PROGRAMS • SERVES 3TH-8TH

Offer students an opportunity to explore deeper into STEAM subjects with eight weeks of instruction focused on science, technology, engineering, arts and math curriculum. Students will practice design thinking, gain confidence with 21st century skills, and increase their interest in STEAM careers and fields of study.



SUMMER LEARNING PROGRAMS • SERVES K-12TH

Help mitigate summer learning loss by offering a full-day “Think Summer” program that combines certificated teachers with paraprofessionals implementing research-based curricula. Alternatively, half-day enrichment program can be added to summer school to encourage participation. All summer programs can be designed with school and student needs in mind.



TUTORING AND HOMEWORK CENTER PROGRAMS • SERVES K-8TH

Provide trained academic coaches in a safe and supportive environment for students to gain homework assistance, get help on specific assignments or classes, learn positive study habits, and create workplans to support missing assignments or failing grades. Tutors can work in small groups or one-to-one, and can be tailored to meet the needs of the students.
